Lesson Structure



Begin with an icebreaker appropriate to the lesson taking into consideration the audience, the lesson objectives, and the approach.



Review material from previous lessons and on-the spot needs assessment for the day's lesson.



Explicitly state the learning objectives of the lesson and its relevance to the course goals. Review agenda/outline.



Introduce new material, provide a model from which participants can increase their understanding.



Create an opportunity for participants to attempt manipulation of the new information, skills or values safely. Guide and assist regularly to produce "error-free" results.



With proficiency under close guided practice, create an opportunity for participants to manipulate the new information, skills or values without instructor input or assistance. Evaluate.



Review the lesson. Give a preview to the next lesson. Assign "homework"/independent practice activity. Encourage/support their learning journey.
